BY-LAW NUMBER 255

A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC LIBRARY
IN THE CITY OF WELLAND.

WHEREAS the members of the Library Association of the City of Welland have by resolution declared their desire that the Library of the Association be transferred to a Board appointed under The Public Libraries Act, and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the assets and property of the Association be taken over and a Public Library established:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WELLAND:

1. THAT in case the assent of the electors is given to this By-Law a Public Library be established in this municipality in accordance with the provisions of the Public Library Act, and that the assets and property of the Welland Library Association be taken over for the purpose of a Public Library.

READ a first and second time this *second* day of December, 1921.

Read a third time this 7th day of February, 1922.
