TRADE AND SKILLS SCHOOLS

In Welland, there are Trade and Technique schools aimed towards adults. They help adults to either obtain their high school diplomas or expand their education to allow them to become skilled in a specific trade. These schools include: Niagara Women's Enterprise Centre, Professional Academy of Hair Design, Alexandria Professional Body Sugaring, and Father Fogarty, an adult Learning school. There are also four driving schools and three music schools located within the city.

To further enhance the learning opportunities of visitors and residents of the City of Welland, there is a public library located in the Civic Square at City Hall.
