Welland – The City of Welland invites citizens to make application to sit on two new committees of Council. The City's original deadline for applications has been extended to Friday, February 15, 2008, due to insufficient response to get the committees up and running.

The Arts and Culture Advisory Committee will advise Council and City staff on ways to advance arts and culture in our community, while the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee will advise Council and City staff on matters that impact the quality of life of senior citizens in the City of Welland. The City is seeking six (6) citizens to sit on each committee for a term of three (3) years.
