Scheduled Water Shut-off for Daimler/Woodlawn Area

For Immediate Release – November 12, 2010 – 4:30 p.m.

Welland – The City of Welland public works division has hand-delivered blue notices to residents and businesses in the area of the Daimler Subdivision of a watermain shut-down planned for Monday, November 15, 2010, between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm. The purpose of the shut-down is to permit the contractor who is performing the final connection of a watermain that was relocated under the 406 at Woodlawn Road and Daimler Parkway as a result of planned MTO improvements.

Although the expected shut down is scheduled between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm, the work may take longer than expected and, as such, residents have been provided with the following information:

- Fill bath tubs and other containers in order to avoid being inconvenienced by having no fresh water
- After the repairs are completed, City crews will flush the watermain to ensure and restore proper water quality.
- Once water service has resumed, you are encouraged, as an added precaution, to run a water tap for approximately 10 minutes, or until the water runs clear, before using the water.
